Hello,

My name is Teresa Koogler and I need your help. My husband Robin and I established the Kate Koogler Canine Cancer Fund, a 501 3 C non-profit organization to raise money for bone cancer research. It is estimated that there will be almost 10,000 new cases of canine bone cancer each year. Bone cancer not only affects dogs but this disease also occurs in humans. According to the American Cancer Society, about 2,650 new human cases of cancer of the bones and joints were diagnosed in 2010 and about 1,460 deaths resulted. Studying this disease in dogs can provide a lot of vital information that can be used in the treatment of people with bone cancer as well.

We wanted a way to honor the memory of a once in a lifetime friend; our dog Kate. As a veterinarian I can't explain how powerless I feel when I have to deliver the diagnosis of cancer to a patient's family. The helplessness was overwhelming as I faced this horrendous disease from a different perspective. Sadly, we lost Kate on September 16, 2002 to chondrosarcoma, a form of bone cancer.

Kate was an awesome dog. We had a trailer custom made for her so she could be pulled behind Robin's motorcycle and join us on our rides. Kate loved her rides. With that in mind it seemed only appropriate to have a motorcycle ride fundraiser in her name. Our hope is to find a way to prevent others from being affected by this horrible disease. We were truly blessed by each day we shared with her and will miss her forever.

The proceeds from The Kate Ride will help to fund a study already underway titled "Genetics of Canine Cancer". Researchers are looking at existing cases of naturally occurring cancer in dogs to determine how genes impact the development of cancer and why certain breeds are over represented in cases of bone related cancers. It is our sincere and genuine hope that the research being done at these centers will give us information that can change the future of canine bone cancer.
